

new homes found for unwanted furniture



At Milnerbuild we are constantly evaluating our business looking for ways in which we can improve the services we provide and work with our local communities. Recently we joined forces with a Leeds charity to help put unwanted furniture and household items to good use.

On behalf of our existing customers and partners we provide **void property solutions**, preparing homes for new tenants. Departing tenants often leave behind **old items of furniture** which have to be disposed of, usually to landfill.

Now, however, **Milnerbuild** donate all useable items to **St Jude's Furniture Store (part of the St. Vincent de Paul Society)**. The charity repairs and refurbishes items and makes them available to individuals and organisations in Leeds who can make use of them.

This scheme has many benefits, **furniture and other household items** which would have ended up in landfill will now be given a **new home**. This means we can help the customers we work with, including **housing associations** and **local authorities**, to meet their obligations to dispose of less waste in landfill. And it means people who struggle to afford everyday items they need for their homes can now get hold of them free of charge.

The redistribution agreement between **St Jude's** and **Milnerbuild** includes furniture, soft furnishings, household items and even electrical goods which **St Jude's** can test and repair before passing them on. **St. Jude's** are thrilled with this scheme they constantly need and rely on donations to help them continue to offer such a valuable service to society.

Furniture and other **household items** which would have ended up in **landfill** will now be given a **new home**.
